2. HOW TO ENROL

- The enrolment for the coming week for « The Pitchouns » club takes place at the Pitchouns' chalet on **SUNDAYS** from 10am to 1pm ;
- The enrolment for the coming week for « The Tigolos » and « The Zigomards » clubs takes place at the KIOSQUE on **SUNDAYS** from 10am to 1pm and on **MONDAYS** from 9am to 10am ;
- The number of places is strictly limited to 16 children per mini club.
- Each child can enrol for a maximum of three half-days per week.

3. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Children must be completely clean and in the event of a problem, the child could be refused ;
 - Smaller children are only accepted if they are potty-trained ;
 - The parents (or responsible adult) must fill in an information form before leaving their child. This will include their mobile phone number where they can be contacted;
 - The mini clubs are naturist and their organizers will ensure that this rule is respected. However, for weather protection, parents must provide a sun-hat, T shirt and a pair of walking shoes ;
 - Swimsuits are obviously not allowed ;
 - Parents must protect their children against sunburn and provide a sun cream adapted to their child's skin ;
 - Children must not bring their own games, toys, valuable objects or money (except for the mini-golf = 1 €) ;
 - Children should bring a small snack. Water is provided.
 - For the whole-day club or evening club, parents must provide a meal ;
 - In case of emergency, the Centre's management can take any measures that they think necessary (doctor's visit, transport to the Polyclinic, surgery, including general anaesthetic , etc.) and this at the parents cost ;
 - The Club's staff will ensure that these rules are respected.
